Call to Order: The special meeting of the City Council was called to order on January 23, 2009 at 5:36 p.m. by Mayor Alan Gaffner.

Ordinance No. 2811
Amendment to the Liquor Control Ordinance:

Moved by Hampton, seconded by Ireland, to pass Ordinance No. 2811, an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2810, Liquor Control Ordinance. Councilman Hampton moved the ordinance amend Section 21-2-5 to delete “The twelve (12) month periods shall be from May 1st of each year to April 30th of the following year” and replace it with “The twelve (12) month period shall run from the first day of the month following license approval to the last day of the month 12 months later”; add a section to indicate “No license shall be issued for the sale at retail of any alcoholic liquor within 250 feet of any school other than an institution of higher learning”; and repeal Section 111.11, Sale of Intoxicating Liquor in its entirety from the Greenville Municipal Code (see ordinance on file for full text).
