Notice of Public Hearing

The City of Greenville in Bond County will conduct a public hearing at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 13, 2014 at the Municipal Building, 404 South 3rd Street, Greenville. The purpose of the hearing is to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally-funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) grant application the City proposes to file.

On or about June 2, 2014 the City of Greenville intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, Community Development Assistance Program (CDAP) under the Public Infrastructure component. The program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will complete water main improvements along Bowman Avenue in the City. The total cost of the project is expected to be \$475,000. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is expected to be \$356,250. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons is greater than 85.52%. The City of Greenville also proposes to expend approximately \$ 118,750 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the City Water Fund.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of May 6, 2014 at the Municipal Building between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to Sue Ann Nelson, City Clerk at the Municipal Building in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
