

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about June 8, 2012 (AT LEAST ONE DAY AFTER THE END OF THE COMMENT PERIOD) the City of Greenville will request THE Illinois Housing Development Authority to authorize the release of HOME Investment Partnership funds under Title (II ) of the (National Affordable Housing Act) of 19(90 ), as amended, to undertake a project known as (the City of Greenville's Single Family Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program HO-50527), for the purpose of rehabilitation assistance for the benefit of low- and very low-income owners in the City of Greenville, Illinois. \$211,000 has been set aside for this project for moderate rehabilitation, and program related administrative expenses.

The activities proposed ARE CATEGORICALLY EXCLUDED UNDER HUD REGULATIONS AT 24 CFR PART 58 FROM NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT REQUIREMENTS An Environmental Review Record (ERR) that documents the environmental determinations for this project is on file at The City of Greenville, 404 S. Third, IL and may be examined or copied weekdays ( 9:00 ) A.M. to ( 4:00 ) P.M.

### CONDITIONS

The current Environmental Review Record represents the first of a two-tiered review. The Environmental Review identifies which statutes will be reviewed and what steps taken to complete the review for each specific site.

### PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the City of Greenville. All comments received by June 8, 2012 (NOTICE DATE PLUS SEVEN DAYS) will be considered by the City of Greenville prior to submission of a request for release of funds to the Illinois Housing Development Authority.

## RELEASE OF FUNDS

The City of Greenville certifies to IHDA that Alan Gaffner in HIS/HER capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. IHDA's acceptance of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and allows the Illinois Housing Development Authority and the City of Greenville to use Program funds.

## OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Authority will accept objections to its release of funds and the ) certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if it is on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Illinois Housing Development Authority's; (b) the Illinois Housing Development Authority's has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient has incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the Illinois Housing Development Authority; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to the Illinois Housing Development Authority at 401 N. Michigan Avenue, Suite 700 Chicago, IL 60611. Potential objectors should contact the Authority to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
