

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals for the **Dewey Street Extension – Water and Street** will be received by the City of Greenville, Illinois, 404 S. Third Street, Greenville IL 62246 in the office of the City Manager until **April 14th 2026 @ 1:00 p.m.**, and will then be publicly opened and read in the Council Chambers.

The proposed work is officially known as **Dewey Street Extension** for the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois. The project shall consist of new pavement construction and watermain construction, at the designated locations shown herein and other miscellaneous work.

Plans, specifications and documents are on file in the office of Milano & Grunloh Engineers, LLC, 114 W. Washington, Effingham, IL 62401.

Proposals must be submitted to the City Manager's Office and shall be enclosed in a separate and sealed envelope endorsed "Dewey Street Extension – Water and Street". Each proposal shall contain the name of every person or firm interested in the same and shall be accompanied by a bid bond, bank cashier's check, bank draft or certified check for not less than five (5) percent of the amount of the bid. A surety bond for the full amount of the award is required. Failure on the part of the contractor to deliver the materials within the time specified or to do the work as specified herein will be considered just cause to forfeit the surety as provided in Article 108.10 of the State of Illinois Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, adopted January 1, 2022.

The City of Greenville reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive or not waive any informality in the bids, and to accept any bid which it deems most favorable to the City.

It is agreed that this bid may not be withdrawn for a period of 45 days from opening thereof or it will be subject to forfeit the 5% Bid Bond provided with the bid.

It is anticipated that a Notice of Award of a contract will be issued within 30-to-45 days of the date bids are received and that a Notice to Proceed will be issued within 10 days of the date of the Notice of Award if contractor provides proper insurance and bonding in a timely manner.

Work on this project is subject to the Illinois Wages of Employees on Public Works Act 30 ILCS 570/ 1-7 is the Public Works Act (820 ILCS 130/1-12) This is the Prevailing Wage Act. Contractor shall not pay less than prevailing wages to all laborers, workman, and mechanics or any other trade performing work under this contract, and shall comply with the requirements of the act stated above. Prevailing Wages, as determined by the Illinois Department of Labor and the current prevailing wages in effect at the time of the work, as established by the City of Greenville. The submission of monthly certified payrolls to the City of Greenville will be required.

Work on this project is subject to the Illinois Substance Abuse Prevention on Public Works Project Act as enacted by P.A. 95-0635.
