

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Greenville will hold a public hearing on September 8, 2020 at 6:45 p.m. at Greenville City Hall, 404 S. Third Street, Greenville, IL 62246, to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federal funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact the City of Greenville, 404 S. Third Street, Greenville, IL 62246 or (618) 664-1644 no later than Thursday, September 3, 2020. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about September 30, 2020, The City of Greenville intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: Construction of a new Water Treatment Plant. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$550,000.00. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons is \$285,670.00. The City of Greenville also proposes to expend \$13,195,500 in non-CDBG funds on the project construction for a total construction cost of \$13,745,500. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: United States Rural Development Funds and City of Greenville Funds.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of August 27, 2020 at the office of Greenville City Hall, 404 S. Third Street, Greenville, IL 62246 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to the City of Greenville no later than September 8, 2020 in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the City of Greenville and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
