

Public Hearing Notice

The City of Greenville will hold a public hearing on June 9, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. at the Greenville Municipal Building. Due to COVID-19, it will be conducted as a virtual hearing. Those interested in listening or participating should call the conference call line at (605)313-6156 and enter access code 227223 prior to 7:00 p.m. The meeting can also be viewed via livestream on the City of Greenville Facebook page. The hearing will provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed Downstate Small Business Stabilization application funded by Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. Persons with disabilities or non—English speaking person who wish to participate in the public hearing and need assistance should contact Sue Ann Nelson, at 618-664-1644, no later than June 8, 2020. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about June 10, 2020, the City of Greenville intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used to provide working capital for the benefit of Fusion Dance Center. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$14,478 and will address the urgent need of the business due to the COVID-19 emergency.

Information related to these applications will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of May 28, 2020 at the Greenville Municipal Building, 404 S Third Street, Greenville, Illinois, or on the City's website at www.greenvilleillinois.com. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the virtual public hearing or by prior written statement.
